Coronavirus scams

There are still a huge number of Covid Scams going around from fake PPI to phony bank messages. Please don't respond to door or phone cold callers and do not click on email links unless you are sure they are legitimate. **MOST IMPORTANTLY –** There is a group of young women knocking on doors, often late at night asking for money. They can become aggressive if challenged. Always check who is at your door before opening it, if you do not recognise them then DO NOT open the door and DO NOT, under any circumstances give them money. They are fraudsters and we do not want to encourage their anti-social behaviour. Call 999 if you are concerned about a cold caller. STAY SAFE.
