### Changes to the Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT)

The last UPDATE reported on changes to the SNT.

Unfortunately Acting Sgt Nicholas Holyomes was moved from the team before we were able to welcome him to Charlton. The team is currently: Inspector Joseph Meares, Sgt Alan Colley, PC's Tom Yardley and Darryl Crossman and PCSO Dave Solly. We will continue to update you on any changes to the policing structure.

There have been changes not only at SNT level but at Borough level. During August Chief Superintendent (CS) Helen Millichap was replaced as the senior police officer in the Borough by CS Dobinson. We welcome him to the patch. You can follow his blog through a link on the Charlton SNT's website

His first blog highlighted successes in reducing drug dealing, gang activity and youth violence, with 18 arrests and seizures of £12,000 and other proceeds of crime. He also issues advice on winter safety, particularly trying to reduce burglary by the promotion of leaving our lights on at night or using timers for lamps and radios if you are away. Good advice given the recent incidents of intruders in back gardens.
