Cold Callers

Please be aware that there is a particularly pernicious cold caller doing 'the rounds' at the moment. He is a middle aged Asian man who knocks quite late at night and then spins a sob story about being locked out. He purports to be a neighbour and is very convincing. The sting is that he wants to borrow money. He assures his victims that he will return and pay it back but of course he never does. Do not be taken in by this crook. If he knocks on your door, get a good description and then report him to the police by either ringing 101 or 0208 721 2734 or 07766 992585. Please alert your neighbours about this scam.
