Our No Cold Callers/Rogue Traders Zone

You may have noticed our street signage that shows that our Watch is now a No Cold Callers/Rogue Traders Zone. The last Charlton Central Residents' Association's (CCRA) newsletter: *'The Grapevine'* included a sticker for you to display on your door or window. If you haven't yet put this up **please display it as soon as possible**. The scheme will only work if we have a very public display that deters rogue traders from knocking. **PUT YOUR STICKER UP NOW.**



Beware Rogue Traders: RBG's Trading Standards warn that gangs are offering to do gardening, paving, guttering and repairs in our area. Having posted cards they then become extremely persuasive. Their work is shoddy and a con. **DO NOT CONTACT FIRMS WHO PUT ADVERTISING THROUGH YOUR DOOR.** The cards change regularly but are often the same group of rogues operating with different names. Crime in our area

At the last Safer Neighbourhood Panel meeting we learnt that burglaries are down compared to this time last year (15 – 6), Robbery are the same (0-0), and Motor vehicle crime is up (14-22), with people leaving their car windows open in the hot weather. Please check your windows are closed and no goods of any value are on display in your car. Crime rates in Charlton are lower than for Greenwich as a whole. Greenwich has about average crime rates compared to other London Boroughs. We would like to thank our local SNT (Sgt Alan Cooley, PC Darryl Crossman, PC Matthew Foletti, PCSO David Solly) for all their hard work in keeping us safe.
