Firearms in Delafield Road

We are delighted to let residents know that the reports of a firearms incident in Delafield Road several weeks ago were hugely inaccurate. The police investigated the incident between a pedestrian and the occupants of a car parked by the Valley cafe. There were no firearms involved at all. Just underlines that fact that your shouldn't believe everything you hear 'on the streets'. Rumour squashed!

Calydon Road Shop

A number of residents have contacted the CCNWatch about several incidents involving anti-social behaviour demonstrated by some young people inside and around the shop on the corner of Calydon and Inverine Roads. It is extremely unfortunate that Jeevan, the very popular shopkeeper, was subjected to some harassment. However, it is good to know that the Safer Neighbourhood Team recently made an arrest and one of the young people involved is now serving a Community Service order. We'd like to thank everyone for their concern and support for Jeevan who provides such a valuable service to our community. Winning the war on crime

Pass on the good news - overall crime in RBGreenwich has dropped by 6.5% in a year. There have been significant reductions in burglary, violence and car crime. Youth offences including knife offences and gun crime are all on the decrease. This overall reduction is pretty much mirrored in the CCNWatch area with the exception of car crime where we are still seeing cars being broken into, largely to steal goods on display. Lock up your valuables and let's see if we can reduce the incident of this type of offence in our area.

Burglaries

A recent burglary in Delafield Road devastated the householder as the entry was through a second floor window. The opportunistic thief climbed a nearby drain pipe to gain access to the window at the back of the property. The Safer Neighbourhood Team have asked us to remind neighbours about securing the back of their properties, especially over night. We haven't had much of a summer to date but on those rare hot and balmy summer nights be sure to lock or secure your windows. It is better to be hot indoors than burgled!
