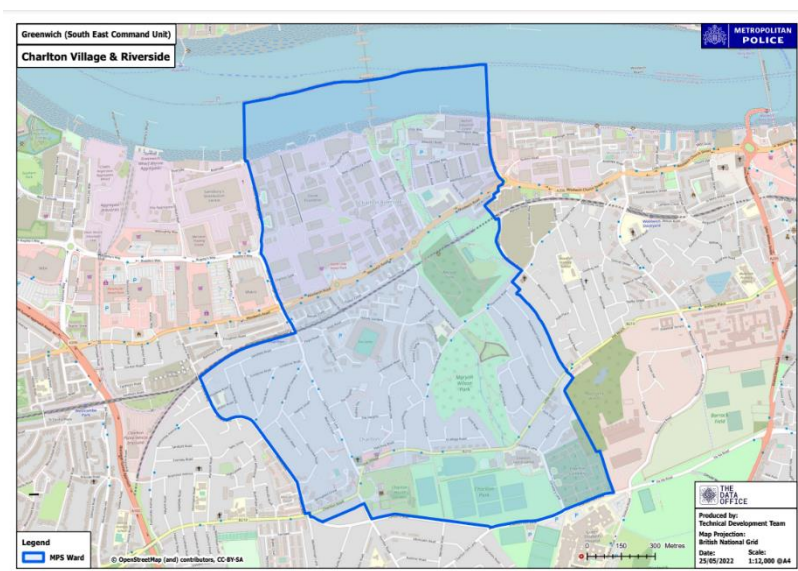
Charlton Village & Riverside Ward

Over the last month your ward officers have been continuing to deal with a range of ASB issues across the ward.

Dedicated ASB Patrol: In response to reports of Anti-Social Behaviour, we've been patrolling Charlton Station, Barney Close, Charlton Church Lane and Charlton Park which are known as hotspots in our ward.

We helped with reassurance visits for burglaries and we have planned to patrol specific targeted areas such as Heathwood Gardens, St.Alfege Road, Charlton Church Lane and The Village.

We have been patrolling Maryon Park and Charlton Park in response to some reports regarding a dangerous dog. We have given some advice to local residents about how to prevent dangerous situation and how keep your dog and public space safe.



We are addressing an indecent exposure incident reported in Woolwich Road. We have notified the community centres in the vicinity such as schools, park visitors and local residents. Daily foot patrols have been deployed to make the area safe. We will keep to investigate the matter.

Ward Officers will be holding on **March 2024** community contact sessions called **“MEET IN THE STREET”**.

This is the perfect opportunity to speak with your local police officers about any local issues, tell us who is committing the crime or ASB in the area, report an incident or an abandoned vehicle, Q&A, offer you crime prevention advice or just to introduce yourself. Why not drop in for a chat?

Our officers have selected the following streets to set up **“MEET IN THE STREET”** sessions:

- **Charlton BR Station** and **Charlton Church Lane** SE7 on *Tuesday 26th March 2024 at 1330pm.*
- **Kinveachy Gardens** SE7 on *Tuesday on 26th March 2024 at 1500pm.*
- **Springfield Grove** SE7 on *Wednesday on 27th March 2024 at 1200pm.*
- **Fossdene School** and **Victoria Way** SE7 on *27th March 2024 at 1500pm.*

We are continuing to assist other agencies with mental health assessments, helping residents with issues related to breaches of the peace, helping with traffic operations in different wards and secure warrants for various matters.

We urge everyone to remain vigilant and to contact their local teams for advice.
