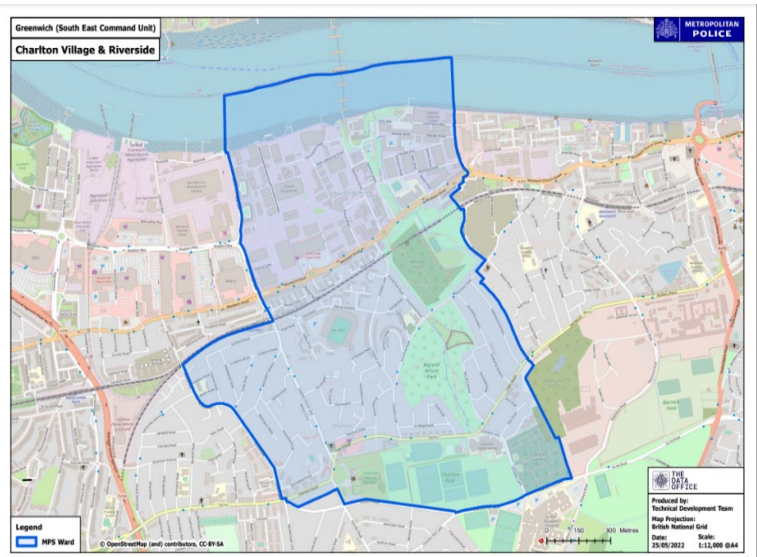
Charlton Village & Riverside Ward

Over the last month your ward officers have been continuing to deal with a range of ASB issues across the ward.

In response to reports of **Anti-Social Behaviour** we have been patrolling most of the hotspot areas such as: *Wellington Gardens, Moore Park, Maryon Park, Charlton Station, Barney Close and Charlton House.*

We are still continuing to help people with reassurance visits for burglaries and a proactive patrol was planned around Maryon Park following the exposure reports. We are continuing to investigate the incident.

Officers have conducted numerous patrols to specific areas in Charlton regarding vehicle crime. The outcome was positive. Four motor vehicles have been recovered and we are actively developing new intelligence to target this type of crime in our ward. A community engagement event that **SNT** is looking to do more often, as this is a great way to interact with younger members of the Local community.

On the **24th of April 2024**, we attended the **Charlton Village & Riverside Ward Panel Meeting** at *Langhorne House*, where the **Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT)** presented crime statistics for the past few months, alongside priorities and action plans to enhance community welfare. Key priorities for the next three months include increased patrols in Maryon Park, Wellington Gardens, The Village, Charlton House and Charlton Park. We will conduct an additional surveillance around Charlton Station who is known as hotspot location for different crimes.

We have assisted other agencies with mental health assessments, helped residents with breaches of the peace, conducted warrants and polling Station patrols.

We worked with joint operations targeting both traffic and robbery offenders, with traffic units, immigration and the Special Constabulary. We have seized a vehicle driving with no licence and insurance.

We urge everyone to remain vigilant and to contact their local teams for advice.
