

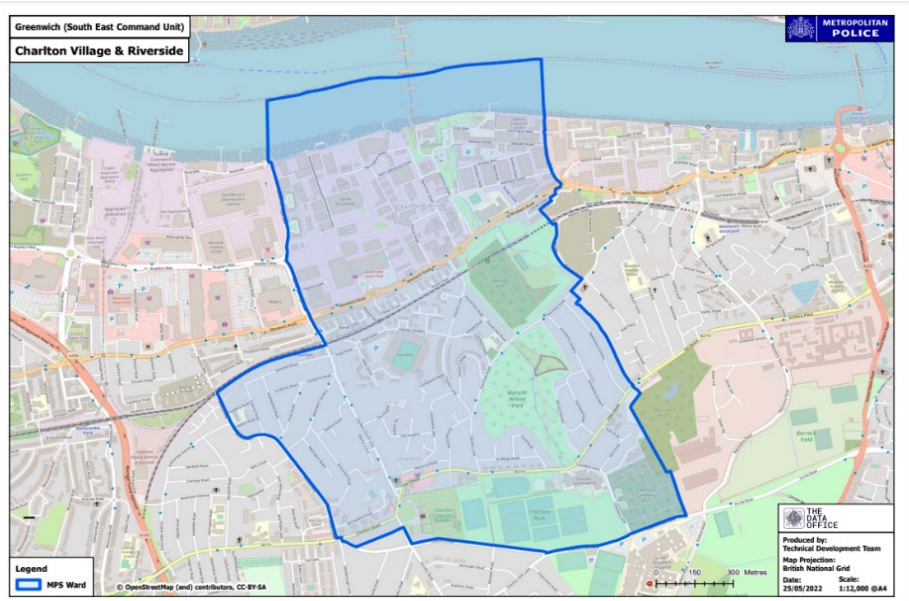

Charlton Village & Riverside Ward

A very Happy New Year to you on behalf of our team.

Over the last month ward officers have been continuing to deal with a range of ASB issues across the ward.

Dedicated ASB Patrol:
In response to reports of anti-social behaviour, we've been patrolling Wellington Gardens, Barney Close, Charlton Station, Charlton Church Lane, Charlton Park and Maryon Wilson Park.



Officers carried out proactive patrols in Maryon Park and Maryon Wilson Park in response to specific reports. An investigation is ongoing.

We are continuing to do reassurance visits for burglaries and victims of crime and we are, also, assisting other wards with crime scenes, arrest enquiries, protests, traffic operations and social events around Greenwich.

During the last month we sent out a Community Safety Survey. The Survey was concerning the safety level regarding Maryon Park and Maryon Wilson Park. This was a good opportunity to get intel from the community and establish what are the priorities in a specific area and what people wanted to be actioned by local police units.

On the 4th of December Charlton SNT carried out VAWG (Violence Against Women and Girls). The initiative aims to increase action against dangerous perpetrators, build women's trust and confidence and help make spaces safer for all women. This was conducted in Charlton Park SE7 at the Old Cottage Coffee where officers were available to speak with members of the public and where leaflets were given out to the community to make them aware of female safety in the area and to keep vigilant.

Also, Charlton SNT carried out vehicle crime patrols in marked police vehicle to conduct checks and stops on vehicles that could be linked or conducting crime on the ward. The offences that vehicles could be linked to could be burglaries, vehicle theft, robbery and drug related offences.

We are continuing to assist other agencies with Mental Health Assessments, helping residents with issues related to Breaches of the Peace, helping with Warrants for various matters.

We urge everyone to remain vigilant and to contact their local teams for advice or in an emergency dial 999.
