## Charlton Village & Riverside Ward

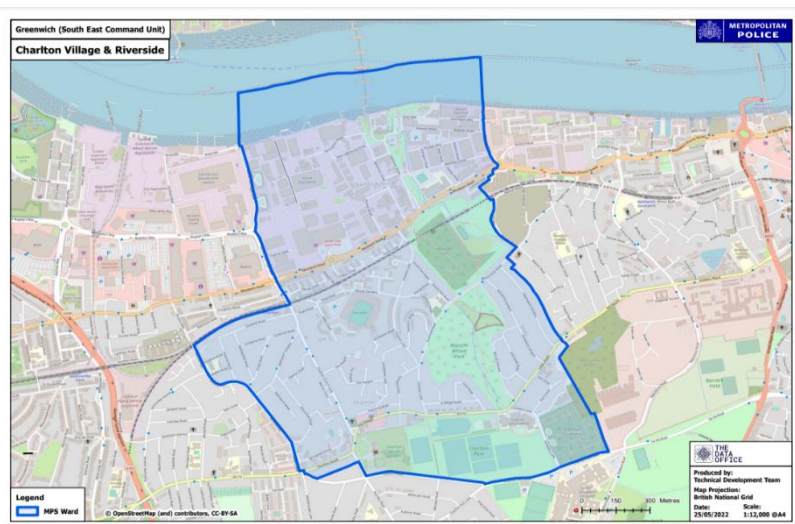
Over the last month your ward officers have been continuing to deal with a range of ASB issues across the ward.

Dedicated ASB Patrol: To Maryon Park, Charlton Station, Barney Close, Charlton House and Charlton Park. In response to reports of Anti-Social Behaviour.

We are continuing to do reassurance visits for burglaries and victims of crime.

Specific foot patrols are in place in response to some reports regarding dangerous dogs and a flasher in Maryon Park and Charlton Park, an investigation is ongoing.

During the last month, the Met has introduces the **OPERATION BROCK** with which we have deployed special reassurance patrol for different local synagogues/religious associations around Greenwich in relation to the conflict in Israel and Gaza.



On the 26<sup>th</sup> and on the 27<sup>th</sup> of **March 2024** your ward officers have been holding an important community contact session called “**MEET IN THE STREET**”. This event was extremely helpful to create a strong connection between people and police and it gave the opportunity to communicate directly with your local police officers about any ASB in the area, report an incident and offer advice.

We, also, have assisted other wards with crime scene, arrest enquiry and protests around Greenwich.

We are continuing to assist other agencies with mental health assessments, helping residents with issues related to breaches of the peace, helping with traffic operations in different wards and secure warrants for various matters.

We urge everyone to remain vigilant and to contact their local teams for advice.
