## Charlton Village & Riverside Ward

Over the last month your ward officers have been continuing to deal with a range of **ASB** issues across the ward.

### **Dedicated ASB Patrol**

In response to reports of **Anti-Social Behaviour** we have been patrolling most of the hotspot areas such as:

- **Charlton Station;**
- **Barney Close;**
- **Charlton Park;**
- **Charlton House;**
- **Moore Park;**
- **Wellington Gardens;**
- **Maryon Park.**

We conducted reassurance visits for victims of vehicle crime, burglaries, shoplifting and other minor crimes.

Specific operations tackling vehicle crime around Charlton. A particular attention was given to Wellington Gardens. After a long investigation, four motor vehicles have been recovered and one person was arrested.

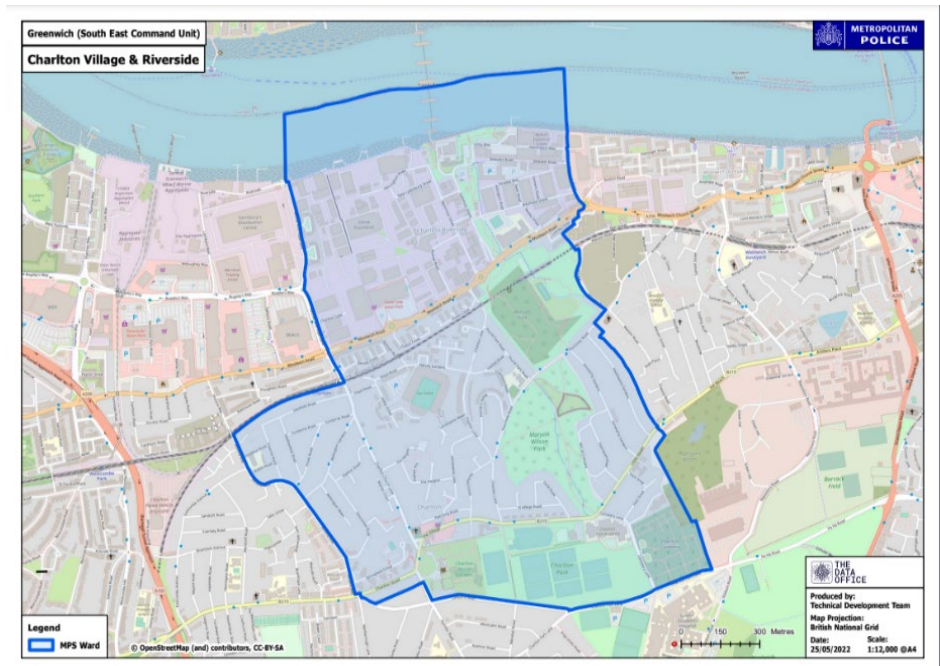

Officers are also supporting external partner agencies with Mental Health Assessments in the ward and assisting residents with issues related to breaches of the peace. Furthermore, research is underway for several locations to secure warrants for various matters, while leasing with other agencies.

We, also, have assisted with traffic operations with traffic units.
