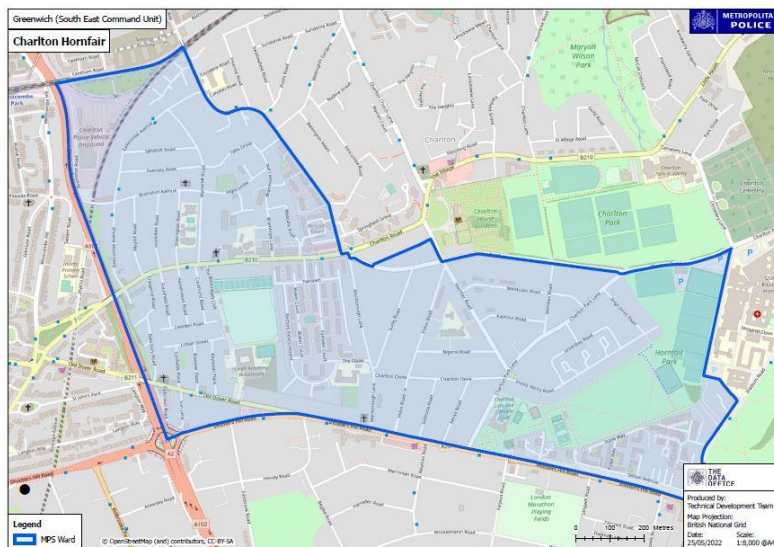

## Charlton Hornfair Ward

The Team met with Charlton Hornfair Ward Panel members at the Blackheath Sports Ground to discuss crime statistics over the preceding quarter and agreed on the wards policing priorities moving forward.

### New Ward priorities are:

- Target violent crime on the ward
- ASB at Tellson Avenue targeted patrols on blocks and vicinity.
- Engagement with local Primary Schools and residents.



Ward panels give residents the opportunity to meet their local policing team and raise any issues which can ultimately dictate where we focus our resources moving forward. Please make enquiries as to how you can get involved with the Hornfair Ward panel.

Our next Ward Panel Meeting will take place on the **18<sup>th</sup> April 2024** at Charlton Hornfair Park at 18:30.

Drop-in surgeries have taken place on the 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of March at, Tellson Avenue , Prince Henry Road, Cherry Orchard Estate Community Café and Lizban Street.

Drop in surgeries give you the chance to meet your local ward team and helps build the communities relationship with the police through information sharing.

We have been continuing to deal with a range of ASB issues across the ward. The team conducted targeted patrols in Tellson Avenue and surrounding areas after receiving reports from residents of anti-social behaviour which include drug dealing and drug consumption. This is still an ongoing issue that we take very seriously and we will continue to target over the coming weeks by undertaking proactive high-visibility and plain clothes patrols.

We continue to support neighbouring ward officers with undertaking mental health assessments (MHA's) by assisting the London Ambulance Service (LAS) and mental health teams at Oxleas NHS Foundation Trust to help support vulnerable persons who are in mental health crises. A fair proportion of crimes committed on our ward can be attributed to suspects in mental health crises and it is therefore really important that we continue to support local mental health services by helping to safeguard these individuals and provide wrap-around-care which can result in a reduction in offending.
