### Good news from our Safer Neighbourhood Team

It is always good to start a community safety Update with some good news.

At a recent meeting of the Charlton Village and Riverside Ward Safer Neighbourhood Policing Panel, our local SNT police team gave us an insight into the work they are doing to keep our community safe.

In the last three months they have:

- Executed a warrant that has led to the arrest of a male stealing motorbikes and stashing them nearby Wellington Gardens.
- Assisted with a warrant executed in Charlton Hornfair leading to the seizure of Class A and B, as well as 14 swords and some knives.
- Continued community engagement with their 'Meet in the Street' initiative – look out for further dates for this opportunity to have an informal chat with the Team.
- Assisted with a Violence Against Women and Girls event which was run with the help of the Volunteer Police Cadets.
- Removed trespassers from Maryon Wilson Animal Park attempting to ride the horses for disabled children. The police have had 'words' with both the young people and their parents.

- Completed a Ward Panel Survey of residents' views on local crime so that the Team can better target areas of concern. Look out for the next survey so that you can anonymously tell the team about areas where drug dealing may be occurring, hot spots for vehicle crime, worrying/dangerous dogs or anything that you think they should know about our area.

### Good news on overall crime in the area

It is good to know that Charlton remains a medium/low area overall for crime. Compared to the crime statistics for the whole Borough, Charlton is, on most metrics, below the rest of the Borough on the percentage of crime. We have less domestic violence and shoplifting. The biggest crime in our area appears to be theft from motor vehicles. This has remained stubbornly high over several years. We continue to remind people not to leave valuables on show in their car, as prevention is the key to bringing the numbers down. Whilst we do have some spikes in drug related offenses and assaults, much of these spikes are largely related to incomers in the area during the football season.
